champagne

Champagne is a sparkling wine produced in the Champagne region of France, which is known for its unique terroir, cool extended growing season and classic grape varieties. Traditional winemaking methods, a history dating back to the 16th century, and unique soils contribute to Champagne being synonymous with quality and therefore making it the most exclusive celebratory drink in the world

BILLECART-SALMON BRUT RÉSERVE **R4,500**

White-fleshed fruits, floral notes and light biscuity notes, complete the delicately textured palate.

BILLECART-SALMON BRUT ROSÉ **R3,750**

Delicate and fresh, with red berry aromas and a graceful, lingering finish.

VEUVE CLICQUOT BRUT ROSÉ **R2,200**

Full-bodied and deliciously fruity, with intense flavours of juicy ripe strawberries and cherries. It is a burst of red fruits and the expression of Madame Clicquot's ingenious and audacious spirit.

VEUVE CLICQUOT RICH **R2,190**

A hint of citrus zest adds a touch of sparkle. Juicy red berries dance on the palate, balanced by the elegant acidity and creamy texture.

MOËT & CHANDON NECTAR IMPÉRIAL **R1,890**

Distinguishes itself by its tropical fruitiness, its richness on the palate and its crisp finish, which instantly surprise and delight.

VEUVE CLICQUOT YELLOW LABEL BRUT **R1,850**

An iconic champagne, vibrant with citrus, apple and brioche notes, offering balance and elegance.



champagne

MOËT & CHANDON BRUT IMPERIAL ROSÉ **R1,800**

Strawberry, raspberry, red currant; the juicy and persistent intensity of the red berries explodes onto the palate, joined by the fleshy, then firm peach aromas.

MOËT & CHANDON BRUT **R1,750**

A lively champagne with bright citrus, green apple and white flower notes, finished with a hint of brioche.

G.H. MUMM BRUT **R1,700**

Delicate and persistent bubbles that release an explosion of flavors on the palate, a nose that reveals a perfect balance of complex and elegant aromas.

G.H. MUMM BRUT ROSÈ **R1,890**

It's intense, fruity character with rich aromas of wild red and black berries, typical of the Pinot Noir grape variety.

G.H. MUMM DEMI-SEC **R1,890**

A rich and generous champagne with notes of ripe fruit, honey and caramel, balanced by a smooth, mellow finish.

prosecco

Prosecco is Italy's beloved sparkling wine, primarily made in the Veneto and Friuli regions from the Glera grape. Unlike Champagne or Cap Classique, Prosecco is crafted using the Charmat method, where secondary fermentation takes place in pressurised tanks rather than in the bottle. This preserves the grape's fresh, fruity character, resulting in a lighter, more approachable style. With its lively bubbles and notes of green apple, pear and white flowers, Prosecco is an easy-drinking, vibrant expression of Italian winemaking.

VALDO PROSECCO MARCA ORO DOC **R520**

Unmistakable fruity aromas with hints of wild apple, golden apple, acacia flowers and honey.

VALDO ICE DEMI-SEC BLANC DE BLANCS **R550**

Persistent, well-rounded taste, delicately exuberant with a pleasantly sweet finish.

VALDO GARDA DOC SPUMANTE BRUT **R380**

Pleasantly dry and savoury taste, harmonious, with a long and persistent finish.

VALDO PROSECCO DOC - EXTRA DRY QUINTINI 200ml **R110**

Easy-drinking and gentle, slim-bodied, with slight residual sweetness, balance and elegance.

cap classique

Strawberry, raspberry, red currant; the juicy and persistent intensity of the Cap Classique is South Africa's version of sparkling wine, made using the traditional method (méthode champenoise), where secondary fermentation occurs in the bottle to create natural bubbles. Typically made from Chardonnay and Pinot Noir, these wines offer complexity, fine bubbles and flavours developed from aging on lees, showcasing South Africa's terroir.

L'ORMARINS PRIVATE CUVÉE ★★★★★ **R980**

A luxurious Cap Classique with layers of citrus, brioche and roasted nuts, offering elegance and depth.

HOUSE OF AZARI BRUT ROSÉ **R300**

Layers of crisp freshness intertwine with ripe berry notes and gentle mineral undertones, culminating in a refined and memorable tasting experience.

HOUSE OF AZARI BLANC DE BLANCS **R300**

Fresh aromas of citrus and green apple are lifted by delicate notes of brioche. The palate is well-balanced and refreshing, leading to a smooth, lingering finish. Lovely as an aperitif.

PIERRE JOURDAN BELLE NECTAR ★★★★★ **R395**

Perfumed rose petals, Turkish Delight, ripe strawberries and a touch of herbs fill the billowing semi-sweet palate, nicely balanced by fresh acidity, ending with a pleasing red berry finish.

PIERRE JOURDAN SILK NECTAR ★★★★★ **R395**

The palate showcases fresh citrus with rich honeycomb ending in a silky, luxurious finish. The slightly sweeter style enhances fruit-driven aromas and creates a softer, more indulgent drinking experience.

PONGRÁCZ BRUT ★★★★★ **R540**

On the palate, delicate yeasty tones, layered with toast and ripe fruit, are enlivened by a firm mousse and persistent bead that make it particularly attractive.

PONGRÁCZ BRUT ROSÉ ★★★★★ **R540**

Delicate yeasty tones, layered with toast and ripe fruit are enlivened by a firm mousse and persistent bead that make it particularly attractive. It imparts a wonderful foamy mouthful of blackberry fruit flavours with a lingering brut aftertaste.

sauvignon blanc

Derived from the French word Sauvage, meaning 'wild', Sauvignon Blanc originated in the Loire region of France. Known for its crisp acidity, regional growing conditions influence its aroma and flavour profile.

CEDERBERG ★★★★★ R372

A vibrant, flavour-packed palate with Cape gooseberry, passion fruit, pineapple, kiwi, lime and tingling acidity, finishing clean with Granny Smith apple.

DIEMERSDAL ★★★★★ R260

Well-balanced, vibrant palate with an array of tropical fruits, ripe figs and gooseberries along with crisp acidity and a mineral character.

PROTEA BY ANTHONIJ RUPERT ★★★ R255

A pure, clean, and refreshing wine with nectarine, peach and tropical fruit flavours, plus hints of grapefruit and quince for added weight and balance.

KEN FORRESTER RESERVE ★★★★★ R240

This wine shows lovely complexity with mix of tangy grassy notes, fig leaf, peach and nectarine nuances.

chenin blanc

Believed to have been one of the first grape varieties grown in South Africa, with a history dating back to 1655, Chenin Blanc is the most widely planted white wine grape variety in South Africa. The versatility of Chenin Blanc allows for various winemaking styles, from fruit-driven to more complex and oaked, making it perfect for food pairing.

KEN FORRESTER OLD VINE RESERVE ★★★★★ R400

Delicate baked apple, peach, caramel and vanilla nuances, harmoniously combine with mix of grassy notes and fig leaf, ending with a zesty finish.

STELLENBOSCH RESERVE ★★★★★ R320

The palate has a lovely fresh, zesty acidity, that mingles with bold tropical fruits along with flavours of citrus, peach and nectarine, with creamy lemon curd texture, salty lees and notes of beeswax.

chenin blanc

STELLENRUST

★★★★ R270

A medley of grapefruit, lime, tropical fruits and pear drop flavours that fill the fresh palate and is complemented by subtle minerality.

PROTEA BY ANTHONIJ RUPERT

★★★★ R225

Fresh stone fruit and lemon flavours are supported by succulent flavours of nectarine, apricot and quince, with a touch of honey.

chardonnay

Chardonnay is a native of the Burgundy wine region in France, grown in nearly every wine-producing country in the world. This versatile variety can be made in a style that showcases the prominent fruit profile or oak aging of Chardonnay, and excellent wines in a number of styles are being produced.

RUPERT & ROTHSCHILD BARONESS NADINE

R710

The refined palate delivers flavours of toasted hazelnut nougat, with yellow-fleshed fruits, harmonising with persistent acidity and a lingering intricate minerality.

MEERLUST

★★★★★ R700

The medium-bodied wine has pear, apricot, peach and floral notes developing into lemon cream with touches of toasted almonds on the stone fruit focused palate.

LA MOTTE

★★★★ R370

Brimming with citrus and juicy peach flavours, with hints of cashew nut and lees rounding out the fresh palate.

DE WETSHOF LIMESTONE HILL

★★★★ R250

Balanced and delicately ripe, with fresh apple, grapefruit and nut flavours, complemented by a chalky, leesy texture. Nuanced and elegant, with a tangy, citrus-filled finish.

HAUTE CABRIÈRE UNWOODED

★★★ R210

Ripe melon, litchi, lime and pear on the vibrant medium-bodied palate, ending with a zippy fruity finish.

natural sweet

KEN FORRESTER PETIT

★★★★

R200

Decidedly moreish flavours of ripe melon, guava and pineapple with subtle florals filling the juicy palate.

rosé

One of the most popular and growing wine categories, sometimes referred to as 'blush' wines, rosé represents a spectrum of colours from the palest salmon to the deepest pink. They are made in one of two ways: from a blend of red and white wine grape varieties; or from red-wine grapes only.

LA MOTTE VIN DE JOIE

★★★★

R270

A polished and juicy palate filled with flavours of melon, grapefruit and nectarine, with hints of sweet candyfloss.

CEDERBERG

★★★★

R230

A fruit-driven dry wine with an abundance of strawberry mousse, Turkish delight and nectarine with a touch of spice and a creamy mouthfeel.

PROTEA BY ANTHONIJ RUPERT

★★★★

R220

Orange citrus notes of grapefruit and tangerine, with strawberry and cherry playing a supporting role to finish the delicate palate.

cabernet sauvignon

A crossing between Cabernet Franc and Sauvignon Blanc dating back to the 17th century in Bordeaux, France, this noble variety is considered to be the greatest of all red grape varieties. Grown throughout the world's major wine-producing countries, it is bottled on its own, or often blended with Merlot or Cabernet Franc.

CEDERBERG ★★★★★ **R550**

Structured and layered palate filled with a combination of mint leaves, spicy pepper, red and black berries that is restrained throughout.

LA MOTTE ★★★★★ **R370**

Ample blackcurrant, violets and mint, with a touch of plum that suffuses the rich palate, full-bodied with notes of cedar and a ripe, fleshy texture.

WARWICK THE FIRST LADY ★★★★★ **R280**

Deep dark fruit flavours with blackberry compote, black plum and dark chocolate coming to the fore, with dried herbs adding complexity to the smooth, velvety finish.

PROTEA BY ANTHONIJ RUPERT ★★★★★ **R255**

An enticing combination of vibrant cherries, blackberry and cassis, with hints of vanilla and plums on the palate, supported by firm tannins and delightful hints of cigar box and sweet almond.

merlot

Originating in Bordeaux in 1783, Merlot translates to "little blackbird" most probably a reference to the grape's distinct colour. Traditionally used as a blending partner to add softness and breadth to Cabernet Sauvignon, but it is increasingly being bottled as a varietal wine, with some superb results locally.

MEERLUST ★★★★★ **R980**

The medium-full-bodied palate offers generous mulberry, tobacco and plum flavours, with hints of dried oak, herbs and spice, tempered by a stony minerality.

DE GREDEL ★★★★★ **R390**

The medium-bodied palate is bursting with fleshy plums and cherry, underpinned by earthy flavours of tobacco and liquorice, caressed by hints of creamy chocolate.

DIEMERSDAL ★★★★★ **R310**

Layers of flavours on the integrated palate of ripe blackberry, dried fruits, undertones of cedarwood, vanilla, mint and spice.

PROTEA BY ANTHONIJ RUPERT ★★★ **R255**

Succulent dark fruits, plum, mulberry and black cherry, with a light sprinkle of spice blending with softly textured tannins.

shiraz

Also known as Syrah, this noble variety originated in the southeastern French wine region, Rhône. Today, Shiraz is the second most planted red grape variety in South Africa. Several styles of Shiraz are produced in South Africa, with cooler, higher-altitude terroirs providing distinctly different flavours than warmer regions

CEDERBERG ★★★★★ R580

Complex and full-bodied with red cherries and mulberry flavours predominate with subtle nuances of mocha, clove spice, pepper and leather.

TOKARA ★★★★★ R330

A medley of wild berries, cedar, baking spice and smoky charcuterie flavours. Alluring freshness and drinkability, ending dry, with beautiful plush tannins and toasty oak.

SARONSBURG PROVENANCE ★★★★★ R280

Ripe red berry, black fruit and plum flavours combine with florals and fynbos, with delicate peppery and spicy touches on the palate.

pinotage

Originating from South Africa, Pinotage offers a spectrum of charm, from lively and accessible to mature and substantial. More than just a fusion of its parent varieties, Pinot Noir and Cinsaut, Pinotage embodies the distinctive spirit of its native country.

L'AVENIR ★★★★★ R350

Flavours of crushed pomegranate and juicy plums are complemented by a sweet spiciness and smooth lingering finish.

LEOPARD'S LEAP SPECIAL EDITION ★★★ R290

Medium-bodied palate with layers of vibrant raspberries and red currant, with subtle vanilla and barbecue spice flavours.

red blends

A red blend is a red wine that includes two or more grape varieties. In South Africa the most prominent varieties for blending are Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Merlot, Petit Verdot and Malbec.

RUPERT & ROTHSCHILD BARON EDMOND

R1,630

Classically structured, with flavours of blackberry, plum, pencil shavings and forest floor. Multi-dimensional palate with complex layers of cherries and liquorice.

MEERLUST RUBICON

★★★★☆

R1,220

The palate is medium-bodied with a forward dark fruit flavour of cassis and ripe plum, cedarwood, fennel and intense spiciness.

ANTHONIJ RUPERT OPTIMA

★★★★☆

R720

The silky, plush textured palate is full of ripe plums, hedgerow fruit, cocoa, spice and cigar box flavours that make for an enveloping mouthful.

RUPERT & ROTHSCHILD CLASSIQUE R575

The layered palate has alluring plush red plum, raspberry and cherry flavours. Smooth, silky textured tannins sustain the spice, toasted caramel and forest floor nuances.

KEN FORRESTER PAT'S GARDEN

R400

Dark berries, plum and cherry flavours blend with graphite, mint and smoky undertones, making it accessible and full-bodied.

LE BONHEUR PRIMA

★★★★☆

R270

Medium to full-bodied wine with a palate that reveals cigar tobacco, cherries, pencil shavings and plum flavours.
